Chapter 1

Paul, called to be an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will of God, and Sosthenes our brother,

1-Corinthians 1: 1

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your church consists of those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, and who call on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the Lord Jesus Christ is Lord of us all.

Lord God, cause Jesus Christ to be my Lord.

Lord God, sanctify me in Christ Jesus.

Lord God, call me to be a saint.

Lord God, cause me to receive the truth, that Christ was buried and rose again on the third day, according to the scriptures.

And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

1-Corinthians 15: 4

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that You bestowed grace on the writer of this letter, and Your grace was not in vain.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your grace in the writer of this letter, allowed him to labor more abundantly than anyone else.

But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.

1-Corinthians 15: 10

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, it was through both the writer of this letter's preaching, and through other people's preaching, that people believed.

Therefore whether it were I or they, so we preach, and so ye believed.

1-Corinthians 15: 11

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that if it is preached that Christ rose from the dead, it should also be preached that there is a resurrection of the dead.

Now if Christ be preached that he rose from the dead, how say some among you that there is no resurrection of the dead?

1-Corinthians 15: 12

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not risen.

But if there be no resurrection of the dead, then is Christ not risen:

1-Corinthians 15: 13

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that if Christ is not risen, then this preaching is in vain, and our faith is also in vain.

And if Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain.

1-Corinthians 15: 14

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that if Christ is not risen, then then the writer of this letter would be a false witness of You, because he has testified that You raised up Christ, who you have not raised up, and if that were the case, then the dead do not rise.

Yea, and we are found false witnesses of God; because we have testified of God that he raised up Christ: whom he raised not up, if so be that the dead rise not.

1-Corinthians 15: 15

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that if the dead do not rise, then Christ is not raised.

For if the dead rise not, then is not Christ raised:

1-Corinthians 15: 16

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that if Christ is not raised, then our faith would be in vain, and we would still be in our sins.

And if Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins.

1-Corinthians 15: 17

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that if Christ is not raised, then those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished.

Then they also which are fallen asleep in Christ are perished.

1-Corinthians 15: 18

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that if Christ is not raised, then if the only hope we have is in Christ, we are the most miserable of all men.

If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable.

1-Corinthians 15: 19

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Christ has risen from the dead.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Christ is the firstfruits of them who have fallen asleep.

But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept.

1-Corinthians 15: 20

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that death came by man.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the resurrection of the dead came by man.

For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead.

1-Corinthians 15: 21

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that in Adam, all die.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that in Christ, all will be made alive.

Lord God, cause me to be made alive in Christ.

For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

1-Corinthians 15: 22

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that men are made alive in their own order, with Christ as the first-fruits, and afterward's those who are Christ's, at his coming.

Lord God, cause me to be placed within the order, of those who are to be made alive, and who will be in Christ at his coming.

But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming.

1-Corinthians 15: 23

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that after those in Christ are made alive, the end will come, where Christ will deliver up Your kingdom to You.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that when Christ delivers up Your kingdom to You, he will have put down all rule, and all authority, and all power.

Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.

1-Corinthians 15: 24

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Christ must reign until he puts all enemies under his feet.

For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.

1-Corinthians 15: 25

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the last enemy to be destroyed will be death.

The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.

1-Corinthians 15: 26

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that although Christ will put everything under his feet, You are the exception, and You are the One who put all things under Him.

For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.

1-Corinthians 15: 27

Lord God, our Father, thank You for Your truth, that when all things are subdued unto Your Son, then the Son himself will be subject to You, who put all things under him, that You may be all in all.

And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.

1-Corinthians 15: 28

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that as pertains to the resurrection of the dead, it is sown in corruption, and it is raised in incorruption.

So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption:

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that as pertains to the resurrection of the dead, it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power.

It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

1-Corinthians 15: 43

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that as pertains to the resurrection of the dead, it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that as pertains to the resurrection of the dead, there is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.

It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.

1-Corinthians 15: 44

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that as we have borne the image of the earthly, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.

Lord God, cause me to be presented with the image of the heavenly, at the sound of the last trump.

And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.

1-Corinthians 15: 49

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that corruption can not inherit in-corruption.

Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.
