Chapter 1

Chapter 22

Chapter 24

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that we should strive to have a clear conscience toward You.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that we should strive to have a clear conscience toward men.

Lord God, cause me to have a heart, that strives to have a clear conscience, towards both You, and my fellow man.

And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and toward men.

Chapter 25

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Paul's accusers had nothing to accuse him for, except about Christ crucified, who Paul affirmed to be alive.

Lord God, give my accusers nothing to accuse me about, except possibly about Christ crucified, and my affirming him to be alive.

Against whom when the accusers stood up, they brought none accusation of such things as I supposed: But had certain questions against him of their own superstition, and of one Jesus, which was dead, whom Paul affirmed to be alive.

Acts 25: 18-19

Chapter 26

Lord God, thank You for having Jesus reveal himself to Paul, as Jesus, the one who he was persecuting.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Jesus appeared before Paul, to make him a minister and a witness of the things he had seen, and of the things Christ would make appear before him.

And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest. But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee;

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Christ delivered Paul from the people, and from the Gentiles he was being set to.

Lord God, thank You for Your word to Paul, that he was sent to open our eyes, turn us from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to You, that we might receive forgiveness of sins, and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith that is in You.

Lord God, cause my eyes to be opened, turned from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to You, that I might receive forgiveness of sins, and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith that is in You.

Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee, To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

Acts 26: 18

Chapter 27

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your angel stood by Paul on the boat that was in danger of sinking, and told him that he was not to fear, that he would be brought to give witness before Caesar, and that You were going to keep all those sailing with him safe.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Paul believed You, that it would be as it was told to him.

Lord God, cause me to be of good cheer, being steadfast in my trust that everything will be as You have told me in Your word.

For there stood by me this night the angel of God, whose I am, and whom I serve, Saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee. Wherefore, sirs, be of good cheer: for I believe God, that it shall be even as it was told me.

Acts 27: 23-25

Chapter 28

Lord God, thank You for Your promise, that Your salvation is sent to the Gentiles, and they will hear it.

Lord God, thank You for sending Your salvation to the Gentiles, and for letting (them / us) hear it.

Be it known therefore unto you, that the salvation of God is sent unto the Gentiles, and that they will hear it.

Acts 28: 28

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Paul dwelt two years in his own hired house, and received all those who came in to him.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that when people came to Paul, he preached with all confidence, and with no man forbidding him, Your kingdom, and those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ.

Lord God, thank You for giving Paul time to receive those who came to him, to preach Your kingdom, and the things which concern Your Son Jesus Christ, with all confidence, and with no man forbidding him.

Lord God, cause me to preach Your kingdom, and those things You would have me preach which concern Your Son Jesus Christ

And Paul dwelt two whole years in his own hired house, and received all that came in unto him, Preaching the kingdom of God, and teaching those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him.
