To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Colossians 1: 2

Lord God, thank You for having others pray for me, who are like-minded, having faith in Jesus Christ, and a love for all the saints.

We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the love which ye have to all the saints,

Colossians 1: 3-4

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that there is a hope laid up for us in heaven.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, in the word of the truth of the gospel, is the claim that there is a hope laid up for us in heaven.

Lord God, cause me to not be alienated, and an enemy in my mind, because of wicked works.

And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled

Colossians 1: 21

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your Son, in the body of his flesh through death, is able to present us holy, without blame, and without reproof, in his sight.

Lord God, cause Your Son in the body of his flesh through death, to present me holy, without blame, and without reproof, in his sight.

Lord God, thank You for Your Son, and for what he has done for me.

In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unproveable in his sight:

Colossians 1: 22

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your gospel, is that which we have heard, and which was preached to everyone under heaven, of which Paul was made a minister.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that we are able to be presented as holy, without blame, and without reproof, in Your Son's sight, if we continue in the faith grounded and settled, and are not moved away from the hope of Your gospel.

Lord God, cause me to continue in the faith grounded and settled, and to not be moved away from the hope of Your gospel.

If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;

Colossians 1: 23

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Paul rejoiced in his sufferings, and taking part in the afflictions of his flesh, for Christ's body sake.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Christ's body is the church.

Lord God, if I should have to suffer in my flesh for the sake of Christ's body, the church, cause me to rejoice in my sufferings.

Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake, which is the church:

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Paul was made a minister, according to the dispensation You gave him for us, to fulfill Your word.

Whereof I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God;

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that You have made known what is the riches of the glory, of the mystery among the Gentiles.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the mystery among the Gentiles, is Christ in us, and the hope of glory.

Lord God, cause Christ to be in me, and give me hope of glory.

To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

Colossians 1: 27

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that it is good to be preached, that Christ can be in us, and we can have a hope of glory.

Lord God, cause Your gospel to be preached, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom, so every man may be presented perfect in Christ Jesus.

Lord God, teach me in all wisdom, and cause me to be presented perfect in Christ Jesus.

Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus:

Colossians 1: 28

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that it is good to labor, and to strive according to Christ's working.

Lord God, cause Your Son to work mightily in me.

Lord God, cause me to labor, and strive according to the works of Your Son.

Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, which worketh in me mightily.

Colossians 1: 29

Chapter 2

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that it is good for our hearts to be comforted, and to be knit together in love, to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of Your mystery, and of the Father, and of Christ.

Lord God, cause our hearts to be comforted, and to be knit together in love, to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of Your mystery, and of the Father, and of Christ.

For I would that ye knew what great conflict I have for you, and for them at Laodicea, and for as many as have not seen my face in the flesh; That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;

Colossians 2: 1-2

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that in Christ is hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Lord God, thank You for Your revealing, that all treasures of wisdom and knowledge are hidden in Your Son.

In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Colossians 2: 3

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that we are able to be beguiled with enticing words.

Lord God, keep me from being enchanted by enticing words that are not the truth.

And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words.

Colossians 2: 4

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that although Paul was not bodily with some of Your believers, he was with them in the spirit, joying and beholding their order, and the steadfastness of their faith in Christ.

Lord God, cause me to have order, and a steadfast faith in Your Son, Jesus Christ.

For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.

Colossians 2: 5

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that to walk with Christ Jesus the Lord, is to firmly root yourself in Him, establish yourself in the faith, and overflow with thankfulness.

Lord God, cause me to be firmly rooted in Jesus Christ, established in the faith, and abounding with Thanksgiving.

As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.

Colossians 2: 6-7

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction, to beware of those who try and take us captive through philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, based on the elemental forces of the world, and not based on Christ.

Lord God, cause me to keep my guard up, and to not be taken in by those who are trying to take me captive through philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, based on the elemental forces of the world, and not based on Christ.

Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.

Colossians 2: 8

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the fulness of the Godhead dwells in Jesus, bodily.

For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

Colossians 2: 9

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Jesus Christ is the head of all principality and power.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that we are able to be complete in Jesus Christ.

Lord God, cause me to be complete in Your Son, Jesus Christ.

And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

Colossians 2: 10

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that we are able to be circumcised, with a circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ.

Lord God, cause me to be circumcised with the circumcision made without hands.

Lord God, cause me to put off the sinful nature, by the circumcision of Christ.

In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:

Colossians 2: 11

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that we are able to be buried with Christ in baptism.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that we are able to be raised with Christ through faith in Your power.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that You raised Christ from the dead.

Lord God, cause me to be buried with Christ in baptism, and risen with him through faith in Your power., knowing that You raised Christ from the dead, and can also raise me.

Lord God, cause me understand that You raised Christ from the dead, and also have the power to raise me.

Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

Colossians 2: 12

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Christ is able to give life to those who are dead in their sins, by forgiving all their trespasses.

Lord God, cause Christ to forgive all my trespasses, and to give me life.

Lord God, while I was dead in my sins, thank You for having all my trespasses forgiven, and for making me alive with Christ.

And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;

Colossians 2: 13

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that because of our trespasses, there is a certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the certificate of debt, with it's legal demands, is contrary to us.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us are able to be blotted out.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us are able to taken out of the way, by Christ nailing it to the cross.

Lord God, cause my certificate of debt, and it's legal decrees which are against me, to be taken out of the way, and nailed to the cross.

Lord God, thank You for blotting out my certificate of debt, and it's legal decrees which were against me, and for taking it out of the way, by Christ nailing it to the cross.

Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Colossians 2: 14

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Christ triumphed over principalities and powers by disarming, disgracing, and putting them to open shame.

And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

Colossians 2: 15

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that it is not good for others to judge us according to what we eat, or drink.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that it is not good for others to judge us in respect of holy days, new moon ceremonies, or Sabbaths.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that restrictions on food, drink, holy days, new moon ceremonies, and Sabbath days were a shadow of what was to come, which is the body of Christ.

Lord God, cause me to not judge others regarding food restrictions, drink restrictions, holy days, new moon ceremonies, and Sabbaths days.

Lord God, cause my conscience to be clear, regarding accusations others may make of me for not respecting food restrictions, drink restrictions, holy days, new moon ceremonies, or Sabbaths days.

Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ.

Colossians 2: 16-17

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that there are people who would try and beguile others of their reward, with false humility and worshipping of angels, claiming knowledge of things they have not seen, and puffed up in their unspiritual mind.

Lord God, keep me from being disqualified of my reward, by people who claim to have visions and are puffed up in their own unspiritual mind about things they have not seen, who desire that I practice false humility and the worship of angels.

Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind,

Colossians 2: 18

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that there are people who would try and beguile others of their reward, who are not connected to Christ, and do not grow with a growth that is from You.

Lord God, keep me from being influenced by people who are not connected to the head, which is Christ, and do not grow with a growth that is from You.

And not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increaseth with the increase of God.

Colossians 2: 19

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that if a person is dead with Christ from the elementary principles of the world, they are not subject to the regulations of the world.

Lord God, cause me to be dead with Christ to the natural element of this world, and to not be subject to it's ordinances.

Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances,

Colossians 2: 20

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that those who are dead with Christ to the basic principles of this world, are not subject to the rules: "Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle," which refer to things that perish with use, and are based on human commands and teachings.

Lord God, cause me to be dead with Christ to the natural element of this world, and give me a clear conscience regarding doctrines of men, such as "Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle," which refer to things that perish with use, and are based on human commands and teachings.

(Touch not; taste not; handle not; Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men?

Colossians 2: 21-22

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the human commands and teachings: "Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle," have an appearance of wisdom in self-made religion, false humility, and neglect of the body, but are of no value against the indulgence of the flesh.

Lord God, cause me to place my faith and hope in Christ, and not in man made disciplines such as, "Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle."

Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh.

Colossians 2: 23

Chapter 3

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction, that if we are risen with Christ, then we should seek those things which are above, where Christ sits on Your right hand.

Lord God, cause me to be risen with Christ, and to seek things which are above, where Jesus sits at Your right hand.

If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.

Colossians 3: 1

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction, that if I am raised with Christ, I should set my affections on things above, and not on things on the earth.

Lord God, cause my mind to be set on things above, and not on things that are on earth.

Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

Colossians 3: 2

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that it is possible to be dead to the things of this world, and to have our real, spiritual life hidden with Christ in You.

Lord God, cause me to be dead to the things of this world.

Lord God, cause my true life to be hidden with Christ, in You.

For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.

Colossians 3: 3

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Christ is our life.

Lord God, thank You for Your promise, that when Christ appears, we will also appear with him in glory.

Lord God, make Christ my life.

Lord God, when Christ appears, cause me to also appear with him in glory.

When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.

Colossians 3: 4

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction, to put to death in our lives, sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desire, and covetousness.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that covetousness is idolatry.

Lord God, put to death in my life, sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desire, and covetousness.

Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:

Colossians 3: 5

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that for the sake of sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desire, and covetousness, Your wrath comes on the disobedient who practice them.

Lord God, cause me to put off sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires, and covetous.

For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience:

Colossians 3: 6

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that we walked, and lived in evil ways, before we began abiding with Christ.

Lord God, cause me to abide in Christ, and to no longer walk, or live in evil ways.

In the which ye also walked some time, when ye lived in them.

Colossians 3: 7

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction, to put off anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, and filthy language from our mouths.

Lord God, cause me to put off anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, and filthy language from my mouth.

But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth.

Colossians 3: 8

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction, that we should not lie to one another, as we have put off the old self with its practices.

Lord God, cause me to put off the old self, with its practices.

Lord God, keep me from using deception and lies.

Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;

Colossians 3: 9

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your children have put on a new self, which is being renewed in knowledge, after the image of You, their creator.

Lord God, cause my new self to be renewed in knowledge after the image of You, my creator.

And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:

Colossians 3: 10

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, having been renewed after Your image, there is no Greeks or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, Barbarian or Scythian, slave or free, but Your Son Christ is all, and in all.

Lord God, give me understanding that it is not important who we are, but that Christ is abiding in us.

Lord God, cause Christ to abide in me.

Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all, and in all.

Colossians 3: 11

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your elect are holy and beloved.

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction for Your elect, to put on heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.

Lord God, cause me to be one of Your elect.

Lord God, cause me to put on heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.

Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;

Colossians 3: 12

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction, to be patient with one another.

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction, to forgive one another.

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction, to forgive those we have angry disputes with, just as You have forgiven us.

Lord God, cause me to be patient with others.

Lord God, cause me to forgive others.

Lord God, cause me to forgive those I have had an angry dispute with.

Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye.

Colossians 3: 13
