**Lord God, cause me to not marvel that Jesus said I must be born again to see Your kingdom.**

**Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.**

**Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so Your Son must be lifted up.**

**Lord God, thank You for providing a way through Your Son, that I might receive life through Him.**

**Also Reference Numbers 21: 8 - And the LORD said unto Moses, Make thee a fiery serpent, and set it upon a pole: and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he looketh upon it, shall live.**

**And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:**

Lord God, cause me to know Jesus as the promised Messiah, and the Christ.

**The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things. Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am he.**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that we should not say the fields are not ready for harvest.

Lord God, thank You for Jesus' instruction, that we should look upon the fields.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that You will not judge men.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that You are the one who sent Your Son.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that You have committed all judgment to Your Son, so all men should honor Your Son, just as they honor You.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that those who do not honor Your Son, do not honor You.

Lord God, place a desire in my heart to honor Your Son, in whom You entrusted judgment of all men. Accept my honor of Your Son as a way to further honor and glorify You.

**For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.**

**John 5: 22-23**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that those who hear Your Son's word, and believe on You who sent him, shall have everlasting life, not come into condemnation, but have passed from death to life.

Lord God, cause me to hear Your Son's word, and to believe on You who sent him.

Lord God, cause me to have everlasting life, and not come into condemnation.

Lord God, cause me to pass from death to life.

**Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.**

**John 5: 24**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the time is soon, when the dead will hear the voice of Your Son, and they that hear will live.

Lord God, cause me to hear Your Son's voice, and live, when he comes to call for his people.

**Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.**

**John 5: 25**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that You have life in Yourself.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that You have given Your Son to have life in himself.

**For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;**

**John 5: 26**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Jesus can do nothing of his own self.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that as Jesus hears, he judges, and his judgment is just; because he does not seek his own will, but Your will, which is the will of his Father who sent him.

**I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.**

**John 5: 30**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that people search the scriptures, thinking they have eternal life in them.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the scriptures bear witness of Jesus.

Lord God, cause me to look to Jesus, not scripture, for the hope of eternal life.

Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.

John 5: 39

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that it is a stumbling block to belief, when we receive honor one of another, and do not seek the honor that comes from the only God.

Lord God, cause me to not esteem the honor of men, but to seek after honor from You.

How can ye believe, which receive honour one of another, and seek not the honour that cometh from God only?

**All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.**

**Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that You sent Jesus down from heaven to do Your will.**

**For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.**

**John 6: 38**

**Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your will, is that of all that You give Jesus he should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.**

**Lord God, give me to Jesus, and cause him to raise me up again at the last day.**

**And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.**

**John 6: 39**

**Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your will is that every one who sees Your Son, and believes on him, may have everlasting life, and Jesus will raise them up at the last day.**

**Lord God, cause me to see Your Son and believes on him, and cause him to raise me up again at the last day.**

**And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.**

**John 6: 40**

**Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that no one can come to Jesus, except those You draw, and Jesus will raise them up at the last day.**

**Lord God, draw me to Jesus, and cause Jesus to raise me up at the last day.**

**No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that men may eat of Jesus, and not die.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that those who do not hear Your words, are not of You.

Lord God, cause me to be of You.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that those who keep Jesus' word, will never see death.

Lord God, cause me to keep Jesus' word.

When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice. But they will never follow a stranger; in fact, they will run away from him because they do not recognize a stranger's voice." **Jesus used this figure of speech, but they did not understand what he was telling them.** **Therefore Jesus said again,** "I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep. All who ever came before me were thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. He will come in and go out, and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. The hired hand is not the shepherd who owns the sheep. So when he sees the wolf coming, he abandons the sheep and runs away. Then the wolf attacks the flock and scatters it. The man runs away because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep. "I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me-- just as the Father knows me and I know the Father--and I lay down my life for the sheep. I have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. I must bring them also. They too will listen to my voice, and there shall be one flock and one shepherd. The reason my Father loves me is that I lay down my life--only to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again. This command I received from my Father."

**John 10: 1-18 (NIV)**

**Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that those who do enter the sheep pen by the door, but climb in by another way, are the same as a thief and a robber.**

**Lord God, keep thieves and robbers from climbing into the pen, and from harming Your sheep.**

**Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that entereth not by the door into the sheepfold, but climbeth up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber.**

**Lord God, as Your sheep, cause us to watch for Jesus to enter the door of the sheep pen.**

**To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out.**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that when Jesus leads Your sheep out of the pen, Your sheep follow him, because they know his voice.

Lord God, cause me to know Jesus' voice, and to follow him.

**And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice.**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Jesus is the door.

Lord God, thank You for Your promise, that those who enter in by Jesus, will be saved.

Lord God, thank You for Your promise, that those who enter in by Jesus, will go in and out, and find pasture.

Lord God, cause me to enter in by Jesus, and be saved.

Lord God, cause me to go in and out, and find pasture.

**I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the thief comes only to steal, kill, and destroy.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Jesus has come so we may have life, and have it more abundantly.

Lord God, cause me to have life through Jesus, and to have it more abundantly.

**The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.**

**John 10: 10**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Jesus is the good shepherd.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Jesus gives his life for the sheep.

Lord God, thank You for Your Son, who is the good shepherd.

Lord God, thank You for Your Son, giving his life for the sheep.

**I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.**

**John 10: 11**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Jesus is the good shepherd.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Jesus knows Your sheep.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your sheep know Jesus.

Lord God, cause Jesus to be my shepherd.

Lord God, cause me to know Jesus, and cause Jesus to know me.

**I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.**

**John 10: 14**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that just as You know Jesus, Jesus also knows You.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Jesus lays his life down for the sheep.

Lord God, cause me to be one of Your sheep, shepherded by Jesus.

Lord God, thank You for Jesus laying his life down for me.

**As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep.**

**John 10: 15**

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that those who are not of Jesus' sheep, do not believe him.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that in this world, we will have tribulation.

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction, that we are to be of good cheer, because Jesus has overcome the world.
