Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that they are blessed who don't do iniquity, but who walk in Your ways.

Lord God, thank You for Your instruction, to keep Your precepts diligently.

Lord God, cause me to keep Your precepts diligently.

Thou hast commanded us to keep thy precepts diligently.

Psalm 119: 4

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that those who have respect for Your commandments, and whose ways are directed to keep Your statutes, will not be ashamed.

Lord God, cause me to have respect for all Your commandments, and direct my ways to keep Your statutes.

O that my ways were directed to keep thy statutes! Then shall I not be ashamed, when I have respect unto all thy commandments.

Psalm 119: 5-6

Psalm 119: 13

Lord God, cause me to rejoice in the path of obedience, much more than in silver and gold.

I have rejoiced in the way of thy testimonies, as much as in all riches.

Psalm 119: 14

Lord God, establish my heart to meditate in Your precepts, and to have respect for Your ways.

I will meditate in thy precepts, and have respect unto thy ways.

Psalm 119: 15

Lord God, cause me to delight in Your statutes, and to not forget Your word.

I will delight myself in thy statutes: I will not forget thy word.

Psalm 119: 16

Lord God, give me a heart to be Your servant, and deal bountifully with me, that I may live and keep Your word.

Deal bountifully with thy servant, that I may live, and keep thy word.

Psalm 119: 17

Lord God, open my eyes, so I may behold the wondrous things out of Your law.

Open thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of thy law.

Psalm 119: 18

Lord God, I do not belong here, do not hide Your commandments from me.

I am a stranger in the earth: hide not thy commandments from me.

Psalm 119: 19

Lord God, cause me to excessively long for, and to seek after Your judgments.

My soul breaketh for the longing that it hath unto thy judgments at all times.

Psalm 119: 20

Lord God, cause me to fear You, be humble, and do not let me stray from Your commandments.

Thou hast rebuked the proud that are cursed, which do err from thy commandments.

Psalm 119: 21

Lord God, cause me to keep Your testimonies, and remove me from reproach and contempt.

Remove from me reproach and contempt; for I have kept thy testimonies.

Psalm 119: 22

Lord God, even if people plot evil against me, cause me to meditate in Your statutes.

Princes also did sit and speak against me: but thy servant did meditate in thy statutes.

Psalm 119: 23

Lord God, cause Your testimonies to be my delight, and my counselors.

Thy testimonies also are my delight and my counsellors.

Psalm 119: 24

Lord God, as my life is in the dust, give me life through Your word.

My soul cleaveth unto the dust: quicken thou me according to thy word.

Psalm 119: 25

Lord God, cause me to declare my ways, answered me, and teach me Your statutes.

I have declared my ways, and thou heardest me: teach me thy statutes.

Psalm 119: 26

Lord God, cause me to understand the way of Your precepts, and talk of Your wondrous works.

Make me to understand the way of thy precepts: so shall I talk of thy wondrous works.

Psalm 119: 27

Lord God, as my heart is heavy, strengthen me according to Your word.

My soul melteth for heaviness: strengthen thou me according unto thy word.

Psalm 119: 28

Lord God, keep me from having false lips, and graciously give me Your instruction.

Remove from me the way of lying: and grant me thy law graciously.

Psalm 119: 29

Lord God, cause me to choose the way of truth, and lay Your judgments before me.

I have chosen the way of truth: thy judgments have I laid before me.

Psalm 119: 30

Lord God, cause me to stick to Your testimonies, and do not put me to shame.

I have stuck unto thy testimonies: O LORD, put me not to shame.

Psalm 119: 31

Lord God, I will run towards Your commandments, as You increase my understanding.

I will run the way of thy commandments, when thou shalt enlarge my heart.

Psalm 119: 32

Lord God, teach me the ways of Your statutes, and cause me to keep them until the end.

Teach me, O LORD, the way of thy statutes; and I shall keep it unto the end.

Psalm 119: 33

Lord God, give me an understanding, cause me to keep Your law, and observe it with my whole heart.

Give me understanding, and I shall keep thy law; yea, I shall observe it with my whole heart.

Psalm 119: 34

Lord God, cause me to go in the path of Your commandments, and make them my delight.

Make me to go in the path of thy commandments; for therein do I delight.

Psalm 119: 35

Lord God, incline my heart to Your testimonies, and not to covetousness.

Incline my heart unto thy testimonies, and not to covetousness.

Psalm 119: 36

Lord God, turn my eyes away from beholding worthless things, and revive me in Your way.

Turn away mine eyes from beholding vanity; and quicken thou me in thy way.

Psalm 119: 37

Lord God, give me a heart to be Your servant, establish Your word in me, and cause me to devotedly fear You.

Stablish thy word unto thy servant, who is devoted to thy fear.

Psalm 119: 38

Lord God, cause me to not bring reproach, for Your judgments are good.

Turn away my reproach which I fear: for thy judgments are good.

Psalm 119: 39

Lord God, cause me to long after Your precepts, and revive me in Your righteousness.

Behold, I have longed after thy precepts: quicken me in thy righteousness.

Psalm 119: 40

Lord God, let Your mercies come to me, and Your salvation, according to Your word.

Let thy mercies come also unto me, O LORD, even thy salvation, according to thy word.

Psalm 119: 41

Lord God, cause me to have an answer for those who reproach me, because I trust in Your word.

So shall I have wherewith to answer him that reproacheth me: for I trust in thy word.

Psalm 119: 42

Lord God, do not take the word of truth from my mouth, because I have hoped in Your judgments.

And take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth; for I have hoped in thy judgments.

Psalm 119: 43

Lord God, cause me to keep Your law continually, for ever and ever.

So shall I keep thy law continually for ever and ever.

Psalm 119: 44

Lord God, cause me to seek Your precepts, and walk at liberty.

And I will walk at liberty: for I seek thy precepts.

Psalm 119: 45

Lord God, cause me to speak of Your testimonies before great men, and not be ashamed.

I will speak of thy testimonies also before kings, and will not be ashamed.

Psalm 119: 46

Lord God, I will delight myself in Your commandments, which I have loved.

And I will delight myself in thy commandments, which I have loved.

Psalm 119: 47

Lord God, I will lift my hands to Your commandments, which I have loved, and will meditate on Your statutes.

My hands also will I lift up unto thy commandments, which I have loved; and I will meditate in thy statutes.

Psalm 119: 48

Lord God, remember Your promises, on which You have caused me to place my hope.

Remember the word unto thy servant, upon which thou hast caused me to hope.

Psalm 119: 49

Lord God, Your promise gives me life, and gives me comfort in my affliction.

This is my comfort in my affliction: for thy word hath quickened me.

Psalm 119: 50

Lord God, even if the prideful ridicule me, cause me to not turn away from Your instruction.

The proud have had me greatly in derision: yet have I not declined from thy law.

Psalm 119: 51

Lord God, cause me to remember Your judgments of old, and have them comfort me.

I remembered thy judgments of old, O LORD; and have comforted myself.

Psalm 119: 52

Lord God, cause me to be seized with horror, at the thought of the wicked who forsake Your law.

Horror hath taken hold upon me because of the wicked that forsake thy law.

Psalm 119: 53

Lord God, cause Your statutes to be my songs, in my earthly life.

Thy statutes have been my songs in the house of my pilgrimage.

Psalm 119: 54

Lord God, cause me to remember Your name in the night, and to keep Your law.

I have remembered thy name, O LORD, in the night, and have kept thy law.

Psalm 119: 55

Lord God, cause it to be my practice, that I keep Your precepts.

This I had, because I kept thy precepts.

Psalm 119: 56

Lord God, cause me to keep Your words, and make Yourself my portion.

Thou art my portion, O LORD: I have said that I would keep thy words.

Psalm 119: 57

Lord God, I have sought Your favor with my whole heart. Be merciful to me according to Your word.

I intreated thy favour with my whole heart: be merciful unto me according to thy word.

Psalm 119: 58

Lord God, cause me to think on Your ways, and to turn my feet to Your testimonies.

I thought on my ways, and turned my feet unto thy testimonies.

Psalm 119: 59

Lord God, cause me to be quick, and not delay keeping Your commandments.

I made haste, and delayed not to keep thy commandments.

Psalm 119: 60

Lord God, even if the cords of the wicked ensnare me, cause me to not forget Your law.

The bands of the wicked have robbed me: but I have not forgotten thy law.

Psalm 119: 61

Lord God, cause me to rise up in the night, and give You thanks because of Your righteous judgments.

At midnight I will rise to give thanks unto thee because of thy righteous judgments.

Psalm 119: 62

Lord God, cause me to be a companion of those who fear You, and of those who keep Your precepts.

I am a companion of all them that fear thee, and of them that keep thy precepts.

Psalm 119: 63

Lord God, the earth is full of Your mercy.

Lord God, teach me Your statutes.

The earth, O LORD, is full of thy mercy: teach me thy statutes.

Psalm 119: 64

Lord God, give me a heart to be Your servants, and deal well with me according to Your word.

Thou hast dealt well with thy servant, O LORD, according unto thy word.

Psalm 119: 65

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that those who believe Your commandments, can be taught good judgment, and knowledge.

Lord God, teach me good judgment and knowledge, for I have believed Your commandments.

Teach me good judgment and knowledge: for I have believed thy commandments.

Psalm 119: 66

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that life's afflictions are able to bring us back to You.

Lord God, before being afflicted, I went astray. But now I keep Your word.

Before I was afflicted I went astray: but now have I kept thy word.

Psalm 119: 67

Lord God, You are good, and do good. Teach me Your statutes.

Thou art good, and doest good; teach me thy statutes.

Psalm 119: 68

Lord God, when the prideful form lies against me, cause me to keep Your precepts with my whole heart.

The proud have forged a lie against me: but I will keep thy precepts with my whole heart.

Psalm 119: 69

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that the hearts prideful people who form lies against the innocent are full of grease.

Lord God, cause me to not have a prideful heart, and to form lies against the innocent.

Lord God, cause me to delight in Your law.

Their heart is as fat as grease; but I delight in thy law.

Psalm 119: 70

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that afflictions can cause us to learn Your statutes.

Lord God, cause my afflictions to teach me Your statutes.

It is good for me that I have been afflicted; that I might learn thy statutes.

Psalm 119: 71

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that your laws are better than gold and silver.

Lord God, cause me to understand Your laws, and to place them in my heart.

The law of thy mouth is better unto me than thousands of gold and silver.

Psalm 119: 72

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your hands have made and fashioned us.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that You can give us understanding.

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that with understanding, we can learn Your statutes.

Lord God, thank You for making me, and for fashioning me.

Lord God, give me understanding, so I may learn Your commandments.

Thy hands have made me and fashioned me: give me understanding, that I may learn thy commandments.

Psalm 119: 73

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that those who fear You, are glad to see others who have hoped in Your word.

Lord God, cause me to have hope in Your word.

They that fear thee will be glad when they see me; because I have hoped in thy word.

Psalm 119: 74

Lord God, I know Your judgments are right, and because You are faithful, I have received affliction.

I know, O LORD, that thy judgments are right, and that thou in faithfulness hast afflicted me.

Psalm 119: 75

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your merciful kindness can be for our comfort.

Lord God, cause me to have a heart to be Your servant.

Lord God, cause Your merciful kindness to be for my comfort.

Let, I pray thee, thy merciful kindness be for my comfort, according to thy word unto thy servant.

Psalm 119: 76

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that Your tender mercies can prolong the life, of those who delight in Your law.

Lord God, cause me to delight in Your law.

Lord God, cause Your tender mercies to come to me, so I may live.

Psalm 119: 79

Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that having a heart that is sound in Your statutes, can cause us to not be ashamed.

Lord God, cause my heart to be blameless regarding Your statutes.
