**Psalm 65: 7**

**Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that those who dwell at the ends of the earth stand in awe of Your wonders. Where the morning dawns, and the evening fades, You make them both rejoice.**

**They also that dwell in the uttermost parts are afraid at thy tokens: thou makest the outgoings of the morning and evening to rejoice.**

**Psalm 65: 8**

**Lord God, thank You for Your truth, that You visit the earth and greatly enrich it. Your river is full of water, for this is how You prepared it, to provide people with grain.**

**Thou visitest the earth, and waterest it: thou greatly enrichest it with the river of God, which is full of water: thou preparest them corn, when thou hast so provided for it.**
